

## Additional Services

These services depend on your street address. If there is NOT a Conference in your area, you may be eligible through our Outreach Centers:

### Furniture and Bed Requests

- Sign ups are the 1st Wednesday of each month at 8:00 a.m.
- The first 50 people in line can apply. A home visit will be scheduled in the following weeks.
- Not all applicants are guaranteed a bed.

### Rent and Utilities Requests

- Partial assistance with a limited number of rent, deposits, water and gas/electric bills

### Food Pantry

- Service limited to residents in the following ZIP codes: 45202, 45203, 45214, 45219, 45216, 45225, 45229, and 45232
- Open: Tuesdays & Saturdays  
10:00 a.m. - noon  
Fridays 9:30 a.m.-noon, 1 p.m - 4 p.m.  
(early sign-in begins at 8:30 a.m.)
- You may visit once per month
- Every time you visit, you must provide:
  - Photo ID
  - Proof of address (current lease or mail from the past 30 days)
  - Documentation of other household members (medical card, ID, etc.)

## Social Services

### Birth Certificates (Ohio only)

- Walk-Ins: 1st Thursday of each month (early arrival suggested)
- Limited to the first 100 people in line or until services end at 11:00 a.m.
- Bring a photo ID if possible
- Each household limited to 2 per lifetime

### Ohio State ID Vouchers

- Walk-Ins: Mondays and Thursdays  
9:00 a.m. - 11:00 a.m.
- Each household limited to 2 per lifetime
- Check the BMV website for necessary documentation before using voucher

### Clothing & Household Items Voucher

- Walk-Ins: Mondays and Thursdays  
9:00 a.m. - 11:00 a.m.
- Bring a photo ID if possible
- Bring verification of household members
- Households eligible to receive voucher once every 6 months

### Bus Tickets

- Help will be considered for transportation to and from new, permanent employment.
- Walk-Ins: Mondays and Thursdays  
9:00 am – 11:00 am
- Bring proof of employment

### Personal Care Products & Baby Diapers

## Pharmacy

To receive eligible prescription medications at no cost to you, you must complete an in-person certification process to join the program. (Recertification required every 6 months.)

### Program Requirements

- For certification: bring photo ID, proof of address, proof of income and paid expenses for the past 30 days, & health insurance card if applicable
- Must be a resident of Hamilton, Clermont, Butler, or Warren County
- Expenses must either be equal to or exceed household income
