Dr. Amar Bhati is a Physician in the field of Internal Medicine in Cincinnati, Ohio. Dr. Bhati is a member of the City of Cincinnati Board of Health as well as the Hamilton County Hospital Commission. He is also President of the Saint Vincent de Paul Charitable Pharmacy Board. He earned his Doctor of Medicine degree from The American University of Antigua College of Medicine where he graduated *Magna Cum Laude*. He earned his Bachelors in Interdisciplinary Studies from The University of Cincinnati.

Dr. Bhati trained at Good Samaritan Hospital where he was Chief Resident as well as Resident Representative for Trihealth's Department of Graduate Medical Education. He made numerous clinical presentations and his medical research has been included in several publications. While working in The Christ Hospital Norwood Primary Care Clinic, he was also able to serve on several committees designing and implementing quality measures system wide.

Dr. Bhati also volunteered on a mission trip to Haiti to provide medical care and education to victims of the earthquake that ravaged the island. He founded the Anant R. Bhati, MD Endowment at The University of Cincinnati in his father's name to assist students in their pursuit of STEM studies. He has also raised funds for UC's Darwin T. Scholars Program. Dr. Bhati works with the Center for Respite Care where free medical care is provided for the homeless after they are released from the hospital. He and his family contributed funds needed to renovate the children's section of the Maderia Library in honor of his late mother who had a life-long love of reading. It has been named The Shammi Bhati Reading Area.
