Our nurse practitioner is available if you do not have a primary care physician. To make an appointment, call a patient advocate at (513)562-8841 x223.



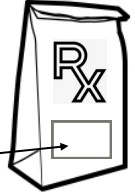
Prescriptions are filled for up to a 30-day supply monthly and may be refilled up to 5 days early each month.



If you cannot text, you may request refills by voice message. You will not receive a call when they are ready. Please allow 48 hours before pick up.



Certification, health screening, and medication review are required every 6 months. Your certification expiration date is written on every bag of medication you receive.



Some drugs may not be available at times. When this happens, a pharmacist will ask your doctor to change to a similar drug that is available.

Every 6 months, you must contact a patient advocate to schedule your certification appointment at (513)562-8841 x223.

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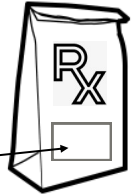

How to Certify

1 Review your eligibility.

- Resident of Hamilton, Butler, Warren, or Clermont County
- Unable to afford your prescription drug costs or insurance co-pays
- No Ohio Medicaid benefits

Please call one month in advance to make an appointment

2 Contact a SVDP Patient Advocate at (513)562-8841 x223 to schedule an appointment.

- Leave a voice message with your contact information, and a patient advocate will return your call within 24 hours.
- Request location for appointment at Neyer Outreach Center or Western Hills Thrift Store.

3 Bring required documentation to certification appointment.

- Appointments without all required documentation will be rescheduled up to 1 month later.
- All documents must be current, within the past 30 days.
- Proof of gross income (before deductions) for all members of the household.
- Proof of expenses required if income is greater than 300% FPL (\$3,220/month for one-person household)
