- When:** Tuesday, Nov. 21: Doors open at 9:00 a.m.; neighbors are usually lined up early.

- What:** St. Vincent de Paul – Cincinnati will distribute boxes of food for Thanksgiving meals to over 1,100 families. Each box includes all the fixings needed for a Thanksgiving family meal, including fresh produce, a turkey and roasting pan.
- No pre-registration is required, and food will be distributed on a first-come, first served basis. Neighbors will need to show their ID and complete a TEFAP form to receive food. Open to residents of Hamilton County.
